As part of the recurring series "Courthouse Steps Decision," A.J., Andy, and copresenter University of Oklahoma College of Law Professor Taiawagi "Tai" Helton explored the ruling in *McGirt v. Oklahoma* and its implications moving forward. The case bars state authorities from prosecuting major crimes committed by Native Americans on the Creek reservation, which the Court held includes much of the City of Tulsa. The ramifications of the ruling appear to go far beyond the strict holding of the Court's 5-4 majority.
