Andy Lester Explores Oklahoma Supreme Court Ruling in Public Nuisance Case

Titled "Oklahoma Curbs Public Nuisance Expansion," Andy describes the Oklahoma Supreme Court's reversal of a \$465 million district court verdict in *State ex rel. Hunter v. Johnson & Johnson*.

"The Oklahoma ruling is a significant step toward retaining traditional notions of public nuisance law and moving away from expanding the claim to include mass torts litigation," Andy explains in the article.
