They will discuss the interplay of patents and regulatory exclusivities, impact of FDA oversight on intellectual property safeguards, common challenges attorneys face in this sphere, strategies for meeting regulatory compliance while supporting patent protection, and the significance of the recent Supreme Court decision, *Hikma v. Amarin*, on skinny-label infringement liability.
