Brian Schoenborn Makes Guest Appearance on My Town Podcast

You can do a lot to impact a lot of lives positively. And so, in sports business and things that I've been able to be involved in, I've been able to do things all over, but I'm still grounded here, and it just means more. It feels more significant and intentional."
