Christine Chasse Examines AI Bias in Health Care for American Bar Association

Spencer Fane attorney <u>Christine Chasse</u> presented at the April 15 meeting for the American Bar Association Tort Trial and Science & Technology Section Medicine and Law Committee. She gave the same presentation last month at a Dallas Bar Association CLE.
