Jessica Merrigan Discusses PFAS at Missouri Water Seminar

Spencer Fane attorney <u>Jessica Merrigan</u> recently addressed a broad range of recent developments related to per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), including health advisories and Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) hazardous substances, at the 17th annual Missouri Water Seminar on July 19. PFAS as CERCLA hazardous substances and issuing formal restriction under the Safe
Drinking Water Act.
