John Watson Examines Public Trust Doctrine for Colorado Bar Association Webinar

Spencer Fane attorney [John Watson](#) co-led a virtual CLE session for the Colorado Bar Association Environmental Section on December 12 that discussed the first-of-its-kind climate change trial, *Held v. Montana*.

During the webinar, The Public Trust Doctrine Montana's Climate Change Lawsuit, John joined Clean Air Council's Alex Bomstein in discussing factors that led to the *Held* decision and its impact. Topics included Montana's constitutionally held right to a "clean and healthful environment," rights in similar states, the history of the public trust doctrine, and climate change cases and initiatives in Colorado.
