Liz Isaac Gives Career Talk to Oklahoma City University Law Students

Spencer Fane attorney [Liz Isaac](#) returned as a guest speaker for the patent law class of Associate Professor Timothy Tau Hsieh at the Oklahoma City University School of Law on April 13.
