Loren Mulraine Champions Equity for Music Artists at Vanderbilt Law School Symposium

Spencer Fane attorney <u>Loren Mulraine</u> was a featured speaker for the Vanderbilt Law School's annual JETLaw Symposium on February 8 in Nashville.

This year's event, Music Law in the Music City, showcased some of the brightest scholars and practitioners in the fields of entertainment and technology law.
