Loren Mulraine Examines Copyright Terminations at Nashville Bar Association Seminar

Spencer Fane attorney <u>Loren Mulraine</u> presented at the Nashville Bar Association's Annual Entertainment, Sports & Media Law Institute on December 6.

This all-day CLE event featured several sessions on significant entertainment law-related topics, including intellectual property, sports, creative arts, and technology developments. Loren's presentation, Termination of Copyright Transfer Under 17 USC § 203, explored challenges related to Section 203 of the Copyright Act. He discussed issues related to the statute's notice requirement, five-year window, and loopholes for loan-out companies and works for hire.
