"I think growing up in the '60s was a very turbulent time for lots of things going on in America. The Civil Rights Movement was very important to me," Charles shared. "It was something that I spent a lot of time thinking about and becoming pretty convicted about in terms of the way civil rights matters were being handled in America."
