Shawn Tuma Highlights Impact of 2022 Data Breaches in Legaltech News

In the article, <u>'Data Is the Hot Potato,' Attorneys Say, as Leaks and Disclosures Soar in 2022</u>, Shawn outlined how this year's series of unplanned data disclosures alarmed the cyber community and why "attempting to place protections on devices and accounts by setting up endpoint protection, encryption, firewalls, and threat protection is moot for regulators if the data itself is not kept secure."

Shawn shared, "We can't really protect everything. We can try, but the odds are pretty good that there are going to be vulnerabilities somewhere. So, we should try to protect the whole data environment, but then use a layered approach by asking: 'Where is our most sensitive data? What's our most risky data?' The data is the risk."
