Spencer Fane Team Analyzes Free Speech on Social Media at TML Conference

The team led the workshop Social Media and the First Amendment, which analyzed free speech issues faced by elected officials when interacting with their community on platforms such as Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, and Instagram.
