Suzanne Odom to Discuss Debt Discharge Limitations Under Bartenwerfer v. Buckley at 2024 ABA LLC Institute

The panel will discuss the opinion and the implications addressed in a concurring opinion that may expand the reach of *Bartenwerfer* to such relationships as tenancies in common, an innocent spouse in a Community Property state, and even a director who gets tagged with liability on a corporate debt resulting from fraudulent acts of a co-director.
