Spencer Fane attorney <u>Arthur Gregg</u> recently presented at The Missouri Bar Civil Practice and Procedure Committee Fall Meeting on tips for successful depositions.

Titled "Striking a Balance on Deposition Objections," Arthur's presentation discussed best practices for asserting (and responding to) objections during depositions.

Arthur also discussed strategies for instructing witnesses not to answer, moving for a protective order in the middle of a deposition, and, if all else fails, adjourning a deposition.
