Jane Dueker Recognized as Someone ‘You Need to Know’ in Missouri Public Policy

Today, Dueker serves as a lobbyist and counsel in the firm’s Governmental Affairs and Litigation practice groups. She is also an active leader and prominent figure in the St. Louis community where she is a regular host and political analyst for local news radio, KMOX, and is the immediate past president of the Board for the Foster and Adoptive Care Coalition.

Dueker has been recognized for a myriad of professional and civic accomplishments throughout her career including most recently when she was named as the “Most Popular” 40 Under 40 2003 class by the *St. Louis Business Journal*.
