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Overview

In this role, June partnered with internal clients to develop, enhance, and sustain compliance program elements for projects to liaise between business clients, legal, and compliance to minimize fraud and abuse risk for all key stakeholders.

Previously, June formed and led her own law firm, which handled hundreds of mergers, acquisitions, and divestitures, with a focus on provider joint ventures that helped clients grow their businesses in a compliant fashion. She provided clients with knowledgeable in-house corporate health care legal services on an outside counsel basis.
